

# SGI Scholarship Application

# Checklist

We're excited that you're applying for an SGI scholarship! To ensure your application is complete and meets all requirements, use this checklist before submitting your application. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

## Complete the applicable SGI Scholarship Application Form

#### Proof of enrollment

- Include a letter from the Registrar's Office confirming full-time studies in the fall semester of the current academic year. If you can't provide the letter by the deadline, indicate this in your application. Recipients must submit proof before receiving the award.
- Scholarships are open to students based in Canada. International students are not eligible.

## Academic transcript

 Submit a transcript showing the required overall grade average from your most recent academic year. Unofficial transcripts are acceptable.

#### Letter of recommendation

- Include a letter of recommendation from a teacher, professor, academic advisor, employer, supervisor, community leader, coach or mentor who can speak to your character, leadership, achievements, skills and abilities.
- Letters from family members, close friends or peers will not be accepted.

#### ■ Written or creative submission

- Choose **one** of the following formats to explain why you should be awarded this scholarship:
  - Essay (no more than 500 words)
  - Video (no longer than 5 minutes)
    Note: If your file exceeds 20 MB, provide a link
    (YouTube, Vimeo, etc.) or attach a compressed .zip file.

• Your submission must highlight:

- · Academic achievements
- Personal growth: Describe a time when you faced a challenge, how you navigated it and what you learned
- Future aspirations: Including career goals and how this scholarship will help you achieve them
- Corporate and Anniversary scholarship only: Leadership, extracurricular, and/or community involvement
- Harold Johnson scholarship only: Your connection to Harold Johnson's life and work, along with your values and beliefs to those demonstrated by the late Harold Johnson

## Resume (optional)

• If you're interested in future career opportunities at SGI (internships, summer jobs or temporary roles), attach your current resume.
